

## Amateur Communications Team Drill Bellhaven Nursing Facility Evacuation 10:00 To 11:00 Hours - August 29th 2015

## **Drill Overview**

- To transport patients from Bellhaven Nursing Home to 4 other facilities via Brookhaven, Shirley and South Country Ambulance service.
- To avoid using patient names as in a real emergency, the drill will assign numbers to each patient.
- Patients 1-5 will be transported to Brookhaven Memorial Hospital
- Patients 6 10 will be transported to Mather Hospital
- Patients 11 15 will be transported to Peconic Bay Hospital
- Patients 16 20 will be transported to the temporary shelter established at the Bellport Middle School

## **Amateur Radio Communications Team Member Response**

- 8 Team members will take part in the drill
- 1 team member will act as Central Command to monitor and record all drill activity
  - Central command will call upon each team member every 10 minutes for status during the 1 hour drill
- 1 team member will be dispatched with the ACT mobile unit to the Yaphank EOC
- 2 team members will be posted at Bellhaven Nursing facility to record the ID of all patients to be transported.
- 1 team member will be posted at each of the 3 hospital arrival areas to record the ID of the patients to insure patients have been transported to the proper facility

• 1 team member will be posted at the temporary shelter to record the ID of any overflow of unexpected patients.

## **Debriefing**

ACT team members will meet at Central Command at 11:30 hours for debriefing
